FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS.

REGARDING STEPHEN MINISTRY

- The application is designed to help you think about becoming a Stephen Minister and to give us an idea of your strengths and talents. We want to help you validate that Stephen Ministry is the ministry at Riverview that you should be involved in, and we need to get to know you so we can make good matches with Care Receivers. Find the application at rivchurch.com/stephen.
- When is the Application Due? Applications are due three weeks before the start of the next class. Each person will meet with a Stephen Ministry Leader to go over their application in an interview.
- I might have to miss some of the training, can I still participate? You will be expected to be at training unless you are unavoidably out of town, in which case, some exceptions can be made. Ask a Stephen Ministry Leader.
- Will there be another class offered? We will be offering a fall class.
- How much will this cost? We are asking everyone to pay the \$70 cost of their training materials. Scholarships are available. Don't let this deter you.
- Will my phone be ringing constantly? No. You will care for one person at a time.
- What if I get in over my head with people who need more care than I can provide? First, you will not be assigned to such a person. Second, the training will help you know to refer a person to professional help. Third, you have Supervision Group, Stephen Leaders, and a pastor who are always there to help you make those judgments.
- How do I apply? Fill out the application. You can pick one up at the Info Center or find it online at *rivchurch.com/ stephen*.
