• Student Ministry Team Lead	 Staff and volunteer leaders are serving in the community (coaching, volunteering at school, etc.). Leaders are a consistent presence in the lives of students and feel confident spending time with students "on their turf". A culture of leaders and students striving to reach others for the Gospel as they also grow in their own faith. High level of care and trust between students and their leaders. Students are engaged in the life of the church by attending weekend services and serving alongside others. Equip leaders in relational ministry best practices by training and modeling. Find/Create opportunities for students to take ownership of the ministry. Train leaders in relational ministry practices and understanding youth culture. Spend time with students at weekend services by attending services with them, connecting with families, and hosting.
