1. Production Intern: (15 hours)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Achieve a tier 2 support knowledge of Riv's audio, lighting, and video system • Production systems are in good working order, operational instructions are complete and up to date • Staff and volunteers are properly trained on production systems needed to fulfill their roles • Staff and volunteers have correct supporting documentation (OOS) for weekend and other productions a few days in advance • Production equipment / system needs are planned, budgeted for, and recommended to Tech Director each year • Upon Tech Director approval, Production equipment is purchased, inventoried, and implemented as needed 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Study production systems designs and Riv's specific implementations • Regularly evaluate and repair production systems as needed • Write and update operational manuals • Provide training on production systems to staff and volunteers • Update and communicate Order of Service and other support documents on a weekly basis • Evaluate what production systems are needed, what systems need improvements, and what systems need replacement throughout the year • Research and plan new, supplemental, and replacement production systems with necessary budget and labor • Work with vendors on procurement of equipment, update assets in inventory, provide financial accounting for all purchases • Establish and execute an implementation plan for new equipment and systems
2.
