Age Group: 5th-6th grade

 Date: April 5, 2020

 Big Idea: Our world will change, but God will stay the same.

 Scripture: Hebrews 13:7-8 (NIRV) Remember your leaders. They spoke God's word to you. Think about the results of their way of life. Copy their faith. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

## Discussion Questions:

- 1. What are you feeling uncertain about right now? What wisdom does God offer us when we're dealing with uncertainty? God shapes us throughout our lives, even when we go through challenges, and helps us to become more like Him. Pick a characteristic of God you want to imitate in this time of uncertainty.
- 2. Read Deuteronomy 6:5-8. Where could you be printing and placing God's Word to encourage yourself or remind yourself about who He is? The scripture specifically mentioned doorposts, but we could write on notecards and place them on our mirrors, fridges, or above our light switches. Regularly reading God's Word reminds us of His character.
- 3. Who are leaders in your life that show great faith? How do you connect with them? Having people in our lives that we can look to in times of uncertainty helps us remember God's promises. Every person that has ever lived has struggled. As followers of Christ, we can react differently to our struggles and feel peace knowing that God is unchanging and we have the promise of Heaven. Remember to reach out to your leaders for guidance.
- 4. A lot of things have changed this week. What is one thing you have control over? Read Philippians 4:4-7. When feeling overwhelmed, we can turn our minds to God and He will bring us peace. We can't control what happens around us, but we can control where we put our trust.
