Discussion:

- Today we talked about how our world will change, but God will always stay the same.
- Let's take a look at our verse again!
 - Hebrews 13:7-8 (NIRV) Remember your leaders. They spoke God's word to you. Think about the results of their way of life. Copy their faith. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.
- Take a second to think about some things in your life that change (you can make a list if you'd like and/or show your kids your picture here).
 - Our bodies grow, our tastes change, the seasons change, and we change grades in school. All of these things change.
 - We may love a certain food one day, but the next day we can't even look at it!
 - What if God were like that? What if we never knew what to expect from Him or how He felt about us? It would be pretty hard.
- This verse says, "Jesus is the same yesterday and today and forever". What do you think that means?
 - It means that God never changes. He is the one we can rely on to always stay the same.
 - His love for us never changes and His views on what is right and what is wrong never change.
 - When we read the Bible, we see just how much God loves His children. He loves us all today, just as much as He loved his children back then.
- God loved us so much that he sent Jesus to be our rescuer.
 - Jesus took the punishment that we deserve for our sins so that if we believe in Him and follow Him, we can be part of God's family forever.
 - No matter what is happening in the world and in our lives, God's love for us never changes!
